Fiscal Year 2020 Impact Report

July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020

Fiscal Year 2020 was an unexpected and unprecedented year. We responded to more than 70 home fires. Notable incidents included multiple Maui Brushfires, a Kauai helicopter accident, the Diamond Head shooting and fire, Kauai flooding, and an Oahu standoff.

April through June was dominated by the COVID-19 pandemic and responding to missions outside our typical scope of work. Our Service to the Armed Forces volunteers served in a major role by taking on positions considered essential during the pandemic. Other volunteers helped feed people in quarantine, distribute meals to the public, and conduct outreach and wellness checks. These impacts are not reflected in the data below.



Responded to 89 disasters



Assisted 363 individuals



Sheltered 176 people after disasters



Supported by 1,541 active volunteers



Educated 1,292 youth about disaster preparedness



Provided 7,582 military service members emergency communications



Briefed 9,793 military service members on Red Cross services



Trained 19,395 people in first aid/CPR/AED



Trained 4,084 people in water safety/aquatics




Location by County






Fiscal Year 2020 Volunteers
