Fiscal Year 2021 Impact Report

July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021

In Fiscal Year 2021, we responded to more than 80 disasters, of which 70 were home fires. We continued to provide help and hope in spite of the COVID-19 pandemic, maintaining safety protocols to protect the public, our volunteers, and staff. Virtual service delivery was skillfully administered during disaster responses, the most notable of which included Hurricane Douglas, multiple Maui brushfires, and Hawaii's worst flooding in 20 years. We proudly ventured beyond our normal mission by offering online resources to manage pandemic-related stress, and we assisted at COVID-19 testing sites and vaccination clinics.

Trained 18,137 people in first aid/CPR/AED




Location by County







Fiscal Year 2021 Volunteers
