# Haiti Earthquake Update

Since the devastating January 12 earthquake, the American Red Cross has raised over \$409 million and to date has spent \$111 million on water, food, shelter, water sanitation, vaccinations and medical care, relief supplies, and cash assistance. About \$100 million more will be spent on meeting the immediate emergency needs of victims over the next 9 months, and another \$200 million on longer term recovery over the next 3-5 years. Since shelter is one of the greatest needs, especially with the onset of the rainy season, the Red Cross network in Haiti is working to provide enclosed transitional shelter for 250,000 people currently living in settlements.
