Red Cross successfully uses RC View—a state-of-the art digital disaster information system that increases speed and reduces costs. Hurricane Matthew lands on the east coast, affecting communities from Florida up through North Carolina.

August/September Three category four hurricanes, Harvey, Irma and Maria, make landfall in Texas, Florida, and Puerto Rico respectively in less than one month.
