

Thanks to our generous volunteers, donors and partners the Red Cross is able to fulfill its humanitarian mission.







Helped 8,110 people affected by 1,834 local disasters, including Derecho, tornado, industrial fires and home fires



Opened 16 shelters, including non-congregate shelters according to our COVID-19 protocols. Provided 27,082 meals and snacks. Distributed 7,988 relief items, including toiletries and clean-up kits as well as financial assistance to individuals across the region



4,426 volunteers are members of our workforce and collectively worked 233,820 volunteer hours



Trained 112,596 people in lifesaving skills through First Aid, CPR & AED, aquatics and babysitting and non-fee enrollee classes



Taught emergency preparedness classes, such as Pillowcase Project to 5,770 students across the region



Collected 129,072 units of blood at 5,422 blood drives



Installed 7,850 smoke alarms and made 7,890 people safer through the Home Fire Campaign



Facilitated 7,544 emergency communications, financial assistance and critical community services for military families
