## New Study Finds that 62% of American Workers Are Not Confident about their Preparedness in the Workplace



A new study by the American Red Cross reveals that many Americans are still not prepared for an emergency situation at home or at work. The study found that:

- Less than half of employees surveyed were familiar with the disaster plan at their workplace;
- Nearly 70% had not received specific information about disaster preparedness in the last 12 months;
- Only slightly more than half (55%) had ever received specific disaster and emergency information from their employer; and
- Only one in ten American households has a family emergency plan, a disaster kit, and training in first aid and CPR.
