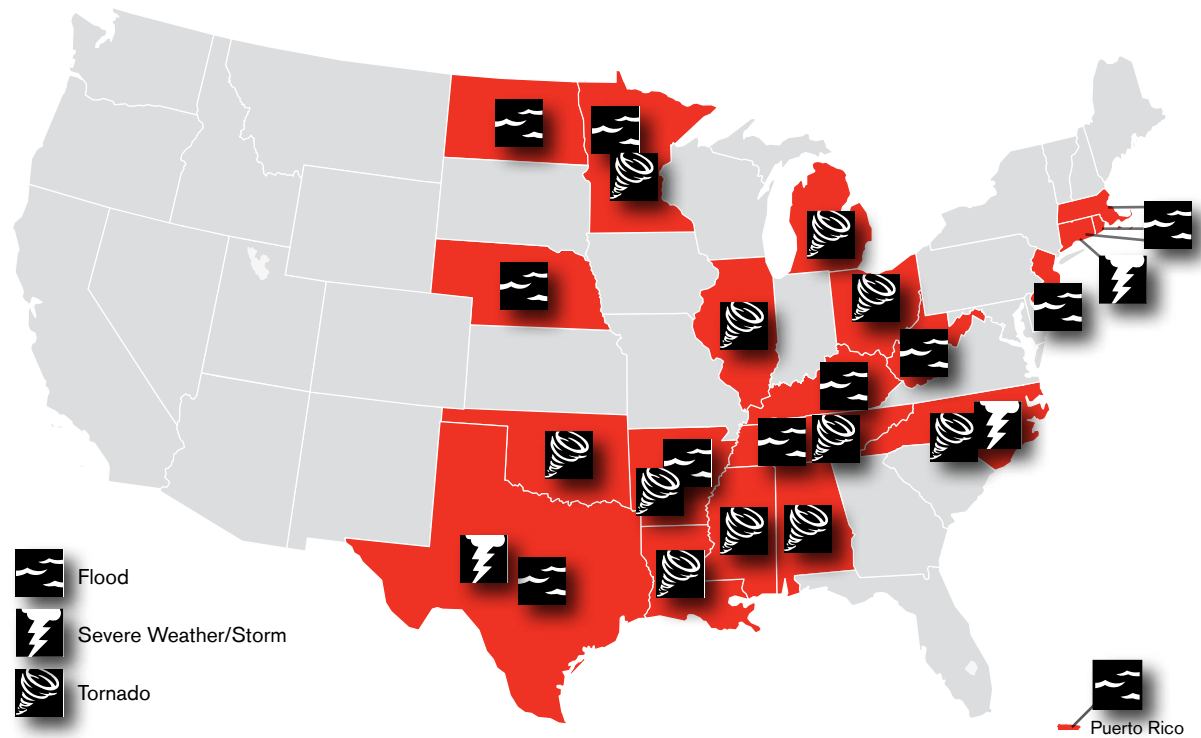


Disaster Victims Need Your Help

How the Red Cross May Use Your Donation to Help Disaster Victims

\$10 provides a hot meal to a disaster victim.

\$30 provides the cost of a cleanup kit and comfort supplies for a family of four.

\$200 provides food and shelter to a family of four for one day in a shelter.

\$425 covers the cost to send an emergency response vehicle to a disaster.

\$1,000 covers the cost to staff a shelter with 10 disaster workers.

\$3,000 covers the cost of cleanup kits and comfort supplies for more than 100 families of four.
