15,000 times a day, a generous volunteer donates lifesaving blood through the Red Cross.

Preparedness, Health and Safety Services

15,500 times a day, a person receives Red Cross health and safety training that can help save a life.

International Services

308,000 times a day, a child receives a measles or rubella vaccination from the Red Cross and our partners.
