Honoring Everyday People Who Perform Extraordinary Acts

2019 Hero Award Categories

Lifetime Achievement: An individual who has made an impact providing humanitarian services for more than 20 years.

Animal Rescue: An animal that saved a life of a human, an ordinary citizen who used lifesaving skills to save the life of an animal(s) or an individual involved in the care or training of animals.

Community Service: An individual who supports a specific need to the community through their personal efforts to help others.

Educator: An educator who used life-saving training or took heroic actions to save the life of another or an individual or individuals that created a new program, provided courses that have had an impact for many years, or did something special to educate others in safety or preparedness.

Family: A family member who did something significant to help a fellow family member or impacted families in the community.

First Responder: First Responders that went above and beyond the job expectations in a significant way.

Firefighter—A professional or volunteer firefighter or dispatch operator whose lifesaving action went above and beyond the call of duty.

Law Enforcement—A law enforcement agent whose lifesaving action went above and beyond the call of duty.

Gift of Life: Someone who created awareness of the importance of blood donations in the community by donating blood personally, inspiring others to give or has been part of scientific advancements to the biomedical community.

Global Citizenship: An individual, group or company who has volunteered or worked to meet the needs of the world's potentially vulnerable populations by building safer, more resilient communities and providing needed relief.

Good Samaritan: An adult who uses their knowledge in prevention, preparedness, safety, or identifies a specific community need to help others, save a life, prevent an injury, or respond to an emergency.

Military: An off-duty military person or a military family member who exhibited significant personal efforts to help others.

Preparedness: Organizations or individuals that have provided a safer environment through safety training and preparedness in the workplace, at home, or in the community at large.

Youth or Young Adult Good Samaritan: A youth or young adult who uses their knowledge in prevention, preparedness, safety, or identifies a specific community need to help others, save a life, prevent an injury, or respond to an emergency.
