# **Disaster event-based volunteering (DEBV)**

#### **Volunteering With the American Red Cross:**

When disaster strikes, the American Red Cross responds immediately — sending trained staff and volunteers to provide food, shelter, relief supplies, emotional support, recovery planning and other assistance to those affected.

Major disaster operations that last for weeks or even months may need the help of thousands of volunteers over time to deliver critical services.

Given the difficult and evolving nature of major disasters, active disaster relief operations are unlike any traditional volunteer efforts often experienced by our corporate partners and their employee volunteers.

Where traditionally we offer our corporate partners more controlled and choreographed experiences, active relief operations are truly the Red Cross in its most essential mission of sheltering and feeding people immediately after a disaster. They are often challenging, exhausting, and unrefined. During major disasters, needs on the ground are evolving — and as a result, volunteer needs and assignments may also be fluid.

#### **Operational Priority Disaster Volunteer Engagement:**

#### Disaster Event-Based Volunteer (DEBV) Opportunities

DEBVs support operational shifts averaging 4–8 hours and receive on-site training for their roles. Volunteers assist with mobile feeding, sheltering, client services, disaster assessment and other operation-specific tasks that expand the Red Cross's capacity during disaster response. Reside within a 60-mile radius of the impacted area.

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Must be at least 16 years old
- In good health and able to work in high-stress environments
- Have a completed profile in Volunteer Connection
- Able to stand or walk for up to 2 hours at a time

#### Individual Registration:

- Employees can preview available DEBV shifts in Volunteer Connection including date, time, location, and logistics.
- Once a suitable shift is identified, complete your profile and register which will include a background check.
- Shifts are updated regularly and may fill quickly—check back often for new opportunities.

**Group Registration:** Group opportunities may not be available for all disaster operations. When available:

- Details will be shared with your relationship manager
- Shifts are typically scheduled 7–14 days in advance
- A group registration form must be completed, and all team members must have profiles in Volunteer Connection
- Shift logistics may change based on operational needs

Any updates to group information must be communicated to your relationship manager and the assigned operational lead.

Volunteer Connection is the enterprise-wide volunteer management system used to engage, match, train and deploy volunteers to respond to community needs and deliver the Red Cross mission. This system offers volunteers an attractive and interactive registration and an on-going, rewarding experience.
