This guidebook is designed to help others know what to do when a loved one has passed away. Condolence Cards

This toolkit contains three different variations of condolence cards. When a client or community member you know loses someone from COVID-19, send them a card that also contains resources.



Community member suffers loss: Someone in your community loses a friend or family member to COVID-19.



Write a personal message: Write them a personal message in a Red Cross Condolence Card and mail



Member receives your card:

Community member receives your card with personal note and is aware and able to connect with the resources at the Red Cross VFAC by phone or website.
