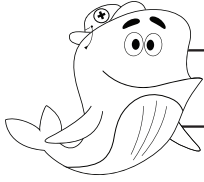

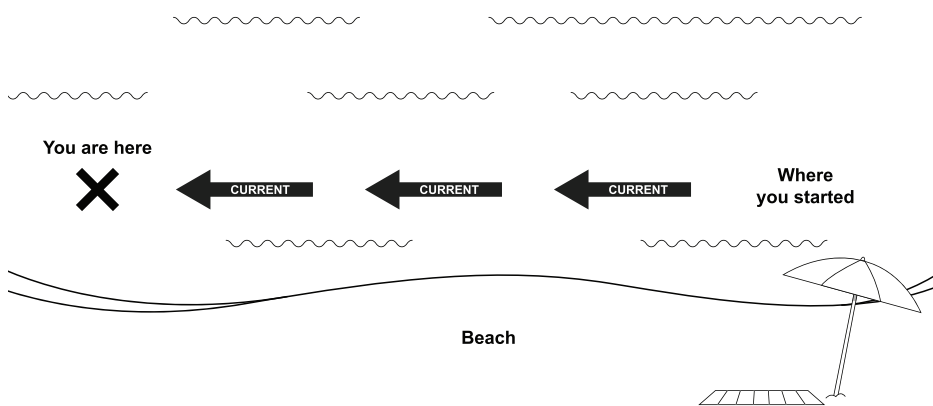


Plot Your Escape—Ocean Currents

Answer each question below using the images provided.

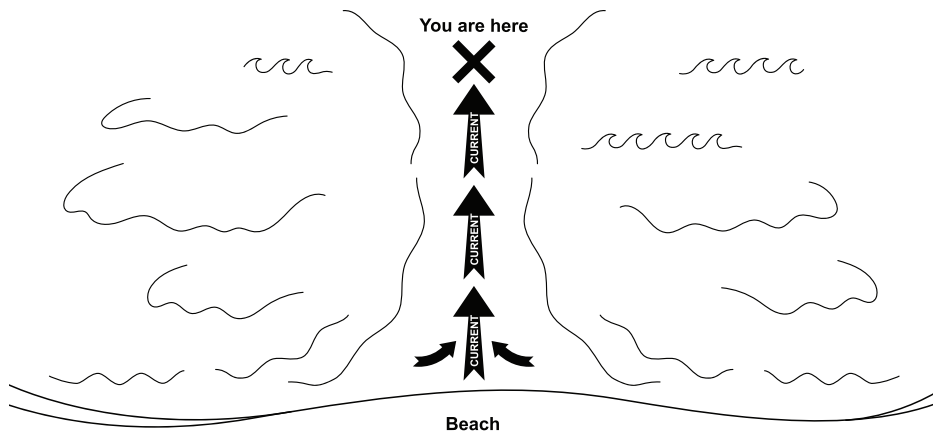
First things first! Finish each statement:
