The IHL Youth Action Campaign

The IHL Youth Action Campaign is an American Red Cross program that encourages youth and young adult teams, aged 13-24, to learn about IHL and empower them to explore these laws through peer-to-peer campaigns.

About IHL

International humanitarian law is the body of law that seeks to protect people and places in armed conflict by regulating the weapons and tactics in war.

Participants will learn about:

- The history and development of IHL.
- IHL principles and core concepts.
- The Geneva Conventions.
- How engagement in outer space by public and private actors is regulated by international law.
- How the use of satellites and the resulting space debris can impact civilian populations and how the law protects them.
- Best practices for building a successful awareness campaign.





This year the theme for the IHL Youth Action Campaign is:

Space Law and Armed Conflict

What consequences does increased human presence in Space pose for civilians and the environment?

How does IHL apply to military, civilian and dual use satellites?

What can we do to advocate for protections in the use of outer space in armed conflict?

IHL and Campaign Building Training

A volunteer coordinator takes youth teams through an interactive training that explores IHL topics and learn how to design an effective awareness campaign.
