2021 RED CROSS VIRTUAL GALA

EVENT HIGHLIGHTS

The San Francisco Red Cross Gala is an annual volunteer-led fundraiser that celebrates the lifesaving mission of the American Red Cross. 2021 marked the 26th year for this event and we were grateful to continue the gala's legacy during the COVID-19 pandemic. We kept our supporters safe and healthy by going virtual and raised vital funds to support Red Cross programs and services throughout the Bay Area.

The 2021 virtual event, held on Wednesday, March 24, raised more than \$215,000 in support of the Red Cross mission. More than 160 households (families) tuned in to watch the livestream broadcast, which, as of the end of March, had been viewed more than 1.7k times. The evening's program featured a welcome from San Francisco Mayor London Breed, heartfelt videos from our honorees, Paradise Police Chief Eric Reinbold and The Clorox Company and shout outs from our Bay Area sports teams, including the San Francisco 49ers, San Francisco Giants and Oakland Athletics. Guests who graciously donated \$10,000, \$2,500 or \$1,000 were entered into a drawing for a chance to win a custom diamond bracelet, courtesy of Katie Anderson Diamonds, or first-class or economy-class round-trip tickets, courtesy of Alaska Airlines.

The gala closed with a performance by local violinpiano duo, LUMOS, featuring Shaina E., who played an LED violin from Spectra Violins, and William Cenote, who played his piano creation called the Luminescent Grand—the only LED piano in existence!

As a thank you for attending, guests received a "Digital Swag Bag" with vouchers and discounts from our partners including: Jackson Family Wines, Ridge Vineyards, San Francisco 49ers, Sports Basement, Tailored Brands and Wines of the Santa Cruz Mountains.

Last year brought another record-breaking year of disasters, leaving people across the Bay Area, Northern California and beyond in desperate need of help. All proceeds from the event will go towards helping people affected by disasters like wildfires and other crises. Since its inception, this fundraiser's purpose has been consistent: to celebrate and sustain the lifesaving programs and services of the Red Cross. While much of our work over the last year and a half has been virtual, the Red Cross still responds to emergencies whenever and wherever they occur. Despite the hurdles of a pandemic, Red Cross volunteers remain committed to answering the call.
