Home fires claim seven lives every day, but having working smoke alarms can cut the risk of death by half. That's why the American Red Cross rallies volunteers and partners to install free smoke alarms, as part of our nationwide "Sound the Alarm" events. Since July 1, 2024, we have:



Installed 1,096 free smoke alarms all around the state of Alaska.



Helped 429 households create home fire escape plans.



Served 1,256 Alaskan residents, including 321 youth, 275 seniors, and 136 individual with disabilities.



Educated 961 students all over Alaska with Youth Preparedness skills.



Responded to 184 home fires, and provided financial assistance and resources to 604 Alaskan residents.



On May 3, 2025, staff, firefighters, donors, and dozens of volunteers came together at the Anchorage Fire Department Training Station to install smoke alarms in Penland Park.
