- Create formal announcements, social media campaigns, and press releases
- Increase volunteer workforce to provide for DHH services and programs

Central Texas Ready Community Plans

Provide American Sign Language (ASL) Disaster Preparedness Training to assist the deaf community prepare for emergencies.

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Install smoke and bed shaker alarms to make homes safer for the 60,000 deaf residents in Austin.

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Collaborate with community partners such as Austin Deaf Club, Austin Community College, Texas School for the Deaf and more.
