a tale of resilience and renewal

In Texas, a new initiative is bringing hope to some of the most vulnerable communities. The American Red Cross has launched the Ready Communities Pilot Program, guided by a vision of collective resilience and a dedication to reducing human suffering.

The program is founded on the principle that we are stronger together and adopts a comprehensive strategy to address the underlying issues of poverty and vulnerability to disasters.

In the Permian Basin, this pilot program is being implemented in the towns of West Odessa and Big Spring. Our aim is to forge stronger community relations and promote self-reliance and resilience in the face of disasters.

Permian Basin Highlights

Prepared over 600 children to respond to flooding, home fires, power outages, and tornadoes.

Partnered with Meals on Wheels Odessa to make 91 homes safer, installing 231 smoke alarms in homes of senior citizens.

Initiated the West Odessa Coalition to build a coalition of nonprofits, individuals, and governmental agencies to improve resilience in the community.

Established relationship with the VA Hospital in Big Spring to provide Resilience Workshops to patients.
