Ready Community: Balcones Heights

This year, our initiative reached new heights through deep local partnerships and hands-on engagement.

Disaster Preparedness

- 513 smoke alarms installed across 181 homes
- 8 bed shakers provided for hearing-impaired residents
- 502 individuals reached through home visits

Volunteer Engagement

 Nearly 400 volunteers participated, including staff, board members, corporate partners, and local leaders

Community Connection

- Resource Fair featured 15+ agencies offering financial literacy, health coverage, and food assistance
- 1,200+ bags of fresh produce distributed
- 19 individuals connected to LGBTQ+ resources via The Pride Center
- Thousands of health and safety items shared, thanks to partners like Broadway Bank, Slay Architecture, and Chick-fil-A
