

The American Red Cross is making a significant investment in Central Texas by rebuilding and expanding its Regional Headquarters in Austin. This project aims to improve efficiencies, enhance the donor experience, and advance blood collection processes.

The Red Cross's work in blood collection and distribution is essential, but Texas currently does not collect enough blood to meet its needs, relying on other regions to fully meet its needs. The recent national appeals for blood donors highlights the urgency.

The new Blood Donor Center in Austin is vital for the community, helping to save thousands of lives annually. From cancer patients and trauma victims to those with blood disorders, safe, reliable blood products can be a matter of life or death.





To meet the rising need for blood products, the new center will host more blood drives and significantly increase blood collection. This expansion will help the Red Cross reach more donors, provide hope in emergencies, and strengthen community resilience. The facility will feature permanent beds and a bright, inviting atmosphere to enhance the donor experience.

To support this initiative, the American Red Cross serving Central and South Texas is launching a **Mission Expansion Campaign.** This campaign will ensure we have the resources to continue providing lifesaving blood, a safe place for disaster clients, and innovative spaces for training and service projects. The new building will host the Blood Donor Center and welcome thousands of corporate partners, blood donors, and community supporters annually

The new building that will serve as the Community Hub for the American Red Cross Serving Central Texas will remain in East Austin, where the Red Cross has been for the last 50 years. This 15,000 sq ft building will serve as the hub in delivering life-saving and mission-critical work. Blood donors, disaster clients, members of the military and their families will all be able to come here to receive the care and support they need. This Community Hub will also be a place for our partners in the area to come together to help everyone in need.

This 15,000 sq ft building will include:

- State-of-the-art bood donor center
- Mobile operations staging area for rapid deployment to disasters
- Multi-purpose meeting rooms
- Innovative, flexible open office space for staff, volunteers, and partners

Being mindful of our impact on the environment, several sustainability measures are taken to ensure that we minimize waste and maximize sustainability. Sustainability measures incorporated into our plans include:

- Energy-efficient systems, including advanced HVAC systems, LED lighting, and smart building technologies
- Mass timber construction which reduces the building's carbon footprint
- Proper ventilation and the use of low-VOC (volatile organic compounds) paints and materials to ensure good indoor air quality
- Low-flow water fixtures to reduce water use
