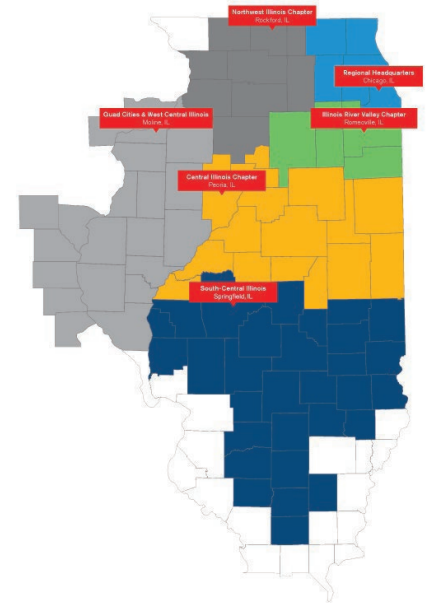

The American Red Cross of Greater Chicago serves 7.7 million people in five counties in Northern Illinois, including Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake and McHenry.

Thanks to our generous volunteers, donors and partners the Red Cross is able to fulfill its humanitarian mission.



Helped **4,287 people** affected by **753 local disasters**, including home fires



Opened **11 shelters**, including non-congregate shelters according to our COVID-19 safety protocols. Provided **16,300 meals and snacks and 1,759 relief items**, including toiletries



Trained **76,499 people in lifesaving skills** through First Aid, CPR & AED, aquatics, babysitting classes and non-fee enrollee classes



2,612 volunteers are members of our workforce and collectively worked **100,361 volunteer hours**



Installed **1,759 smoke alarms** and made **1,632 people** safer through the Home Fire Campaign



Collected **36,275 units of blood** at **1,274 blood drives**



Facilitated **3,944 emergency communications, financial assistance and critical community services** to military families



Taught emergency preparedness classes, such as Pillowcase Project to **2,746 students**
