The Bay Area Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers and people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 4,296 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to 378 disasters, primarily home fires, and helped make 1,843 homes safer through preparedness and resilience programs.



Collected 83,266 units of lifesaving blood for patients at hospitals and cancer treatment centers.



Opened 282 emergency cases for military members, veterans and their families and engaged 1,254 participants in military health and wellness programs.



Delivered first aid, CPR, AED, water safety and caregiving training to more than 48,957 residents.



Engaged 452 participants through our Restoring Family Links course, which helps reconnect loved ones separated by crises and emergencies.
