The Central Valley Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers and people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 939 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to 196 disasters, primarily home fires, and helped make 830 homes safer through preparedness and resilience programs.



Delivered lifesaving blood products through our nationwide blood bank, which accounts for 40% of the nation's blood supply.



Opened 279 emergency cases for military members, veterans and their families and engaged 6,424 participants in military health and wellness programs.



Delivered first aid, CPR, AED, water safety and caregiving training to more than 17,475 residents.



Engaged 2,424 participants through our Restoring Family Links course, which helps reconnect loved ones separated by crises and emergencies.



The Red Cross donated shuttle carts to support safe transportation for veterans and families at the Fresno VA, especially critical during extreme heat.
