Helped 1,410 families through 751 disaster responses, the majority of these home fires.



Collected 52,766 units of lifesaving blood from 1,803 local blood drives.



Provided 1,945 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 17,660 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 4,432 people in aquatics and water safety.



Opened 15 cases and provided 34 case activities to help families separated by war and humanitarian crisis.
