Responded to 495 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 980 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 52,826 units of lifesaving blood from 2,161 local blood drives.



Provided 1,667 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 27,966 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 11,091 people in aquatics and water safety.



Educated 508 people about helping families separated by war and humanitarian crisis through our Restoring Family Links program.
