The Heart of the Valley Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers, and the people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 687 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to 236 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 472 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 24,182 units of lifesaving blood from 1,362 local blood drives.



Provided 949 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 9,506 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 687 people in aquatics and water safety.



Educated 508 people about helping families separated by war and humanitarian crisis through our Restoring Family Links program.

Thank you for your generous support, which makes our mission alleviating human suffering in the face of emergencies—possible.



169 smoke alarms were installed in 71 homes during *Sound the Alarm* events in Stockton and Los Banos, making 210 residents safer in case of a home fire.
