The North Bay Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers, and the people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 521 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to 114 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 227 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 1,820 units of lifesaving blood from 83 local blood drives.



Provided 1,044 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 13,566 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 1,875 people in aquatics and water safety.



Educated 508 people about helping families separated by war and humanitarian crisis through our Restoring Family Links program.
