Responded to 100 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 174 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 16,449 units of lifesaving blood from 531 local blood drives.



Provided 691 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 14,613 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 2,256 people in aquatics and water safety.



Educated 374 people about helping families separated by war and humanitarian crisis through our Restoring Family Links program.
