Responded to 377 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 817 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 70,661 units of lifesaving blood from 2,065 local blood drives.



Provided 787 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 28,522 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 9,146 people in aquatics and water safety.



Engaged 2,946 participants through our Restoring Family Links, Youth Action Campaign and International Humanitarian Law program.
