The North Bay Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers, and the people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 495 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to 91 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 140 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 2,002 units of lifesaving blood from 79 local blood drives.



Provided 299 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 11,807 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 1,787 people in aquatics and water safety.



Engaged 116 participants through our Restoring Family Links, Youth Action Campaign and International Humanitarian Law program.



Red Cross Service to the Armed Forces volunteers supported the Wings Over Solano Air Show, teaching Hands-Only CPR to 200+ and engaging 400+ in disaster preparedness.
