Responded to 87 disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened 176 disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected 20,874 units of lifesaving blood from 555 local blood drives.



Provided 435 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 16,147 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 2,331 people in aquatics and water safety.



Engaged 929 participants through our Restoring Family Links, Youth Action Campaign and International Humanitarian Law program.
