The Kern Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers and people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 597 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to 174 disasters, primarily home fires, and helped make 1,106 homes safer through preparedness and resilience programs.



Delivered lifesaving blood products through our nationwide blood bank, which accounts for 40% of the nation's blood supply.



Opened 139 emergency cases for military members, veterans and their families and engaged 1,583 participants in military health and wellness programs.



Delivered first aid, CPR, AED, water safety and caregiving training to more than 8,326 residents.



Engaged 50 participants through our Restoring Family Links course, which helps reconnect loved ones separated by crises and emergencies.



A mother and daughter volunteer team is helping protect families through Sound the Alarm, making community service a family tradition.
