The Bay Area Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers, and the people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by **4,300** dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to **392** disaster events, the majority of these home ires, and opened **898** disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected **55,606** units of lifesaving blood for patients at hospitals and cancer treatment centers.



Opened **278** cases and provided **1,061** case services for military members, veterans and military families.



Trained 33,694 people in First Aid/CPR/AED.



Engaged 1,175 youth in emergency preparedness.



In October, our Training Services team and Dozier-Libbey Medical High School hosted a record-setting youth CPR/AED certification event for nearly 350 students at Antioch's Park Middle School.
