Responded to **63** disaster events, the majority of these home ires, and opened **105** disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected **7,535** units of lifesaving blood for patients at hospitals and cancer treatment centers.



Opened **134** cases and provided **597** case services for military members, veterans and military families.



Trained 5,896 people in First Aid/CPR/AED.



Engaged 500 youth in emergency preparedness.



We launched two new programs this year: the partnerfocused Community Adaptation Program, and the Animal Visitation Program which brings smiles to veterans at the VA in Marina.
