The Heart of the Valley Chapter serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers, and the people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by **811** dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, over the last fiscal year we have:



Responded to **248** disaster events, the majority of these home fires, and opened **396** disaster cases to help those affected to recover.



Collected **23,241** units of lifesaving blood for patients at hospitals and cancer treatment centers.



Opened **234** cases and provided **881** case services for military members, veterans and military families.



Trained 10,259 people in First Aid/CPR/AED.



Engaged 134 youth in emergency preparedness.



During the 2025 Sound the Alarm signature period this spring, the Red Cross and our community partners installed **99** free smoke alarms in Merced homes, making **139** residents safer from home fires.
