Andrea began working for the American Red Cross in Westchester County in 1998. During her tenure she has held the positions of Youth coordinator, Director of Volunteer Management & Human Resources Chief Operations Officer of the Westchester Chapter of the American Red Cross. In 2011 with regional restructuring Andrea became the Regional Director of Facilities/Real Estate Management for the new Greater NY Region of the Red cross. Most recently Andrea has been

promoted to Regional Volunteer Services Officer beginning March 7, 2022.

In her roles Andrea has supported the Disaster Relief of local and large-scale disasters such as 9/11, Hurricane Katrina and Hurricane Sandy.
