It is the selfless actions of others that the American Red Cross of Western New York relies on to provide help and hope to those in need of a blood transfusion, in the wake of a disaster, or support for our troops. The Real Heroes Celebration showcases those who share that same spirit by demonstrating courage through an act of heroism or dedication to their community through volunteerism.

Please join us as we pay tribute to these amazing individuals. Your support makes a difference to our very own neighbors who are helped by the Red Cross wherever the need is greatest.



\$500 can provide 49 service members or veterans in hospitals with a Red Cross bag filled with comfort items such as a washcloth, shampoo, soap, comb and other necessities.



\$1,500 can cover the cost of a local disaster response, such as a home fire, which includes deploying two volunteers and a vehicle to provide financial assistance to one affected family.



\$3,000 can provide 93 military families with emergency communications regarding death or serious illness of a family member, birth of a child or grandchild or other emergencies.



\$5,000 can cover the cost of the average blood drive, plus testing and blood donor care.



\$7,500 can cover the cost of 441 smoke alarms, which the Red Cross installs in homes at no cost to the owner to prevent home fires, the most common disaster Red Cross volunteers respond to.



\$10,000 can provide breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks, cots, two blankets and a comfort kit for 140 people in a Red Cross shelter.

Please know that on average, 90 cents of every dollar donated to the American Red Cross goes to support mission delivery, not overhead. You can be assured that your support of our event will impact many lives across Western New York.

Western New York Real Heroes Award Categories

Animal Rescue

Presented to the family of a pet who was instrumental in saving a life, or an individual who was instrumental in saving an animal's life.

Blood Donor

Presented to an individual or organization who has helped save countless lives through blood donations or acted as an advocate for blood donations in the community.

Community Service

Presented to an organization or individual(s) whose cumulative contributions benefit the community.

Education

Presented to an educator or layperson who used life-saving skills to save the life of another in an educational setting or had a significant impact inside or outside of the school.

Fire Rescue

Presented to a firefighter or firefighters, volunteer or paid, whose life-saving actions exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.

Good Samaritan Adult (21+)

Presented to an individual 21 years or older who used life-saving skills to save the life of another, or had a significant, meaningful impact upon the life of another.

Good Samaritan Youth (20 & under)

Presented to an individual 20 years or younger who used life-saving skills to save the life of another, or who had a significant, meaningful impact upon the life of another.

Law Enforcement

Presented to a law enforcement officer whose life-saving actions exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.

Lifeline

Presented to a 9-1-1 dispatcher or caller who utilized emergency communications or preparedness to save the life of another.

Medical

Presented to a medical professional, EMS volunteer or organization whose life-saving action or preparedness exemplifies the very highest standards of their calling.

Military

Presented to a member of the Armed Forces (active or former, commissioned or non-commissioned) whose lifesaving actions or preparedness exemplify the very highest standards of their calling, or to a person or organization dedicated to Veteran Services.

Workplace Safety

Presented to a business owner, manager, or employee whose preparedness or life-saving actions in response to a workplace emergency exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.
