
Nick and Cindy volunteer their time to many organizations in the Greater Akron community. Cindy serves on the Humane Society of Summit County Board and enjoys

Presenting Sponsor: \$15,000

Mobilizing for a large, local, disaster

Sponsorship at this level covers the cost to feed and shelter 150 clients for 3 days in a shelter given there is a large-scale disaster in this area such as a tornado, flood or long-term power outage.

Sponsorship benefits:

- Logo bug on screen for more than 30 minutes during event
- Opportunity to speak on your company's philanthropic philosophy during the event

Mission Sponsor: \$10,000

Providing relief for disaster victims and support for military service members

Sponsorship at this level can provide 40 comfort kits for hospitalized service members. It will also support the cost to deploy six specially trained Red Cross Volunteers to an operation, and includes travel, transportation, lodging, food and vital support systems like our Volunteer Connection portal.

The average length of a disaster deployment is 11 days.

- Bringing the event experience home for your 10 guests, with home delivery of 3-course meals

Humanitarian Sponsor: \$7,500

Supplying those affected by disaster with supplies, food and hope

Sponsorship at this level provides the average cost of fully stocked Emergency Response Vehicle with needed supplies for 3 days - This service includes providing lunch, dinner and snacks, the travel costs to deploy 2 staff members to operate the Emergency Response Vehicle and vehicle maintenance and fuel costs.

Lifesaving Sponsor: \$5,000

Sponsorship at this level provides the installation of 20 specialized smoke alarms to local deaf and hard of hearing communities, and over 133 standard smoke alarms

Response Sponsor: \$2,500

Meeting urgent needs

Sponsorship at this level protects 100 children from measles through our international programs and provides financial assistance for four families impacted by a local disaster, such as a home fire. This assistance helps a family purchase items immediately after a disaster, such as food, lodging, clothing and other critical needs.
