The American Red Cross Ready when the time comes (RWTC) program allows organizations to give back to the community by empowering teams from businesses or organizations to act as disaster-relief volunteers during disasters as well as support the Red Cross mission through a diverse array of programs and services.

The RWTC program provides a complete system for recruiting, training and activating volunteer teams-placing them in critical support functions during the disaster cycle: prepare, respond and recover, and engaging them in mission-related work for the Red Cross. Member organizations and companies only need to commit to a volunteer training and allow employees to serve as Red Cross volunteers.

How does it work?

Recruit and train volunteers

- Your organization partners with the Red Cross to recruit a minimum of 10 people to establish a team.
- The Red Cross provides training for your team in sheltering, mass care, bulk distribution, etc., while offering ongoing training and volunteer opportunities, such as disaster drills and preparedness events.
- Your organization commits to hosting the on-site training and allowing the team to serve in volunteer opportunities.

Activation

- For a disaster or non-disaster event, the Red Cross will assess the volunteer needs and then notify your organization's designated Team Leader of the recruitment needs.
- The Team Leader will check the availability of members and mobilize the team that would support the event.
- The team will work alongside Red Cross employees and fellow volunteers.

Training

All RWTC volunteers will complete a basic volunteer training. It includes an orientation to the Red Cross, detailed information about the RWTC program, and the Disaster Services: an Overview course. Additional training will be based on your local Red Cross chapter's needs and may include training in call center support, volunteer intake and processing, and disaster assessment, among other trainings.
