## Mr. Kim R. Kadesch Director of the Office of National Capital Region Coordination (ONCRC)

Mr. Kim R. Kadesch was appointed as the Director of the Office of National Capital Region Coordination (ONCRC) on 12 August 2013. Prior to this appointment, he served for four years as the Executive Officer in the Office of the Associate Administrator for Response and Recovery at FEMA. Mr. Kadesch joined FEMA in 2008 as a member of the Federal Coordinating Officer (FCO) cadre, assigned to FEMA Region III.
