The California Gold Country Region serves people facing emergencies every day, and embracing the diversity of our staff, volunteers, and people we serve is vital to this work. Powered by 1,100 dedicated volunteers and generous donors like you, in 2021 we:



Served over 42,000 meals and opened over 85 shelters across 14 counties and 2 states for people affected by wildfires and home fires.



Delivered 4,135 units of blood from 142 regional blood drives with 1,550 units for the Sickle Cell Initiative.



Reached 920 youth via the Pillowcase Project and Prepare with Pedro as well as 568 individuals through Community Preparedness Education.



Provided 1,463 emergency services, 424 critical community services and 827 family follow up services to members of the military, veterans and their families.
