Responded to **758** single- and multi-family fires; made **616** homes safer; opened **27** evacuation shelters



Hosted **243** blood drives; collecting **6,909** units of blood, including **97** matches for our Sickle Cell Initiative



Managed 693 emergency communication/critical community cases; served 90 veterans via resiliency workshops; serviced 79 Restoring Family Links cases



Trained more than **29,000** people in first aid, CPR and AED skills



Deployed **234** people to **34** major disaster response operations nationwide



More than 1,900 volunteers supported the California Gold Country Region during fiscal year 2025, contributing more than 136,400 volunteer hours.
