

Special Events Internship Fall 2025

The fall Special Events Internship position supports all four special events in the Illinois region: planning for *Evening of Stars*, helping with auction and chef research for *A Taste on the River*, management of our *Team Red Cross* Chicago Marathon charity running team, and nominations research and outreach for *Heroes Breakfast*.

Ideal candidates can start in August.

Ideal candidates are located in Chicago or Bloomington/Normal.

Chicagoland candidates must be able to work the Chicago Marathon on October 12, 2022. Bloomington/Normal candidates should be able to work Evening of Stars, late October 2025.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Support planning and logistics for Bloomington/Normal Evening of Stars event.
- 2. Support the nomination sourcing, editing, review, and selection process for the *Heroes Breakfast*.
- Support planning, logistics and execution of Team Red Cross Marathon events, including Chicago Marathon Abbott Health & Fitness Expo booth and Marathon Day tent in Grant Park.
- 4. Research and solicit food and beverage donations needed for Team Red Cross events.
- 5. Manage restaurant and auction donor research for Quad Cities A Taste on the River event.
- 6. Assist with special event coordination and planning, including but not limited to event acknowledgements, online host platform logistics, vendor research and working with event volunteers.
- 7. Assist with data entry, mass mailings, filings and other administrative tasks as needed.
