

# TITLE VI BENEFICIARY NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

## YOUR CIVIL RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI

**The American Red Cross Wheels adheres to the Civil Rights Act of 1964 which states: “No person in the United States, shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.” For more information on the Title VI transit obligations, please see the contact information below.**

### MAKING A TITLE VI COMPLAINT

**Any person who believes he/she has been subjected to discrimination in the delivery of or access to public transportation services on the basis of race, color, or national origin, may file a complaint with American Red Cross Wheels. Such complaint must be filed in writing with American Red Cross Wheels no later than 180 days after the alleged discrimination. **Written complaints may also be filed with the U. S. Department of Transportation/Federal Transit Administration (FTA) no later than 180 days after the date of the alleged discrimination, at the following address: Office of Civil Rights, Attention: Title VI Program Coordinator, East Building, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor-TCR, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20590.**

## NOTICE POSTING LOCATIONS

The Notice to Public will be posted at many locations to apprise the public of The American Red Cross Wheels program’s obligations under Title VI and to inform them of the protections afforded them under Title VI.
