Mission Spotlight



As an AmeriCorps member in Red Cross Disaster Cycle Services, I wear many hats: preparedness, response, and recovery—the everimportant triangle of disaster operations. On July 4, 2022, I was deployed

to a devastating fire at an apartment complex in Clifton Park. Among those affected were a 43-year-old man and his son. Although they walked away safely, they lost everything in that fire. Everything. This man lost the last remnants of his father, the meaningful heirlooms he meant to pass on to his son, valuable possessions, important identification cards, and they lost their home.

This man sat devastated in the Red Cross office on the brink of tears with no idea what to do next. It's never enough, but we provided monetary assistance, comfort kits, and a plethora of resources. When disasters happen in our community, it reminds me how important my many hats are, especially preparedness: community education, installing smoke alarms, inspiring youth to action, and training our Red Cross volunteers in disaster operations lay the foundation for helping our neighbors prepare for disaster. On that fateful day, a man without hope came to our office with nowhere to go and left with tools to help him rebuild and start a new foundation.

Here is how the American Red Cross Eastern New York Region has impacted lives this past year:



Responded to **684** local disasters, providing relief to **1,264** families impacted by home fires, floods and other emergencies.



Served **2,458** military families and provided **6,705** case services to aid veterans, service members and their families.



Installed 2,563 free smoke alarms and made 1,401 local homes safer by presenting fire safety education and other lifesaving resources.



Enrolled **43,285** people in first aid, CPR, water safety, babysitting and other lifesaving skills.



Trained **4,503** people in free disaster training programs to help adults and children prepare for emergencies.



Collected 101,928 units of blood from volunteer donors to support area hospitals and patients in need.
