As the headquarters for the American Red Cross of Alaska, the Anchorage office accounts for 80% of our staff and volunteers, houses most of our emergency supplies and equipment, is the location of our training room, and acts as the Emergency Operations Center during times of disaster.

The office is comprised of outdated and inefficient workspaces which have over time become a barrier to communication, collaboration, and effective mission delivery. It's been 24 years since the Anchorage office has had any significant updates or improvements.

Renovating the Anchorage office will create efficient and appropriate spaces, increase capacity for communication, and increase staff and volunteer recruitment and retention. A successful outcome will instill confidence in our clients, partners, volunteers, and the community in our ability to deliver on our mission.

Renovations include new paint, flooring, office furniture, windows, and building signage. Complete budget available on request.

Anchorage Office Project Funder

\$200,000 | Platinum Sponsor

Overall project funder for renovating office space, common areas, restrooms, lobby and providing new signage inside and outside the building. Sponsorship covers all renovation costs. Command Center

The Volunteer Workspace includes computers, tables, storage, and resources needed for our volunteers to provide mission-critical services. This area is used during disasters, for volunteer trainings, meetings and other events. Disaster Client Room

\$20,000 | Gold Sponsor

The Disaster Client Room is where the Red Cross is able to provide help and hope to families impacted by a disaster. Families come into the office and are offered emergency supplies, mental health services, financial assistance and a hug. Conference Room

\$15,000 | Silver Sponsor

The Conference Room acts as a multi-function office space. It's uses include workspace for visiting staff and volunteers, Board meetings, donor meetings, staff collaboration, joint virtual calls, and other miscellaneous needs. Training Services Room

\$10,000 | Silver Sponsor

The Training Services Room is used for first aid, CPR and AED classes available to the public. These life-saving skills are taught by Red Cross certified instructors. Workforce Lounge

The Workforce Lounge is the hub of social connection at the Anchorage office.
