Provided relief and recover support, including financial assistance, to 692 households impacted by disasters and assisted 2,339 individuals.



In Oregon and Washington, we delivered more than 251,475 units of blood from more than 8,630 blood drives to 60+ area hospitals and cancer treatment centers.



Provided services to military members, veterans and their families 11 times a day.



Trained more than 40,000 people in First Aid, CPR & AED, water safety, babysitting and other lifesaving skills.
