## **Nomination Guidelines**

- Seeking nominations for the duration of January 1, 2022 January 28, 2023.
- Deadline to submit nominations is January 31, 2023.
- Nominees must live in, or the action must have occurred in Broome, Chenango, Cortland, Delaware, Otsego, Sullivan, Tioga, or Tompkins Counties in NY, or Susquehanna County in PA.
- If chosen as a Hero, nominees must be available for videotaped interviews in person or through virtual platforms, dependent upon COVID-19 guidelines at that time.
- If chosen as a Hero, nominees must be **amicable to promotion of this event through various media platforms** (social media, print and TV).
