Nomination Guidelines

- **Seeking nominations for the duration of January 1, 2022 – January 28, 2023.**
- **Deadline to submit nominations is January 31, 2023.**
- **Nominees must live in, or the action must have occurred in Steuben, Schuyler, Chemung, Broome, Chenango, Cortland, Delaware, Otsego, Sullivan, Tioga, or Tompkins Counties in NY, or Susquehanna County in PA.**
- **If chosen as a Hero, nominees must be available for videotaped interviews in person or through virtual platforms, dependent upon COVID-19 guidelines at that time.**
- **If chosen as a Hero, nominees must be amicable to promotion of this event through various media platforms (social media, print and TV).**

Award Categories (please select all applicable)

Animal Rescue: Presented to the family of a pet who was instrumental in saving a life, or an individual who was instrumental in saving an animal's life.

Blood Donor: Presented to an individual or organization who has helped save lives through blood donations, created awareness of the importance of blood donations, helped to ensure a sufficient blood supply is available, and/or acted as a blood services advocate for the community.

Education: Presented to an individual or team who used life-saving skills to save the life of another in an educational setting, or an educator who had a significant impact inside or outside of the school.

Fire Rescue: Presented to a firefighter(s), volunteer or paid, whose life-saving actions exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.

Good Neighbor: Presented to an individual(s) or professional rescuer(s) involved in rescuing a person from a life-threatening situation or who had a meaningful impact in the life of another or the community.

Good Samaritan - Adult (21+): Presented to an individual(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another, or had a significant, meaningful impact upon the life of another.

Good Samaritan - Youth (20 & under): Presented to an individual(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another, or had a significant, meaningful impact upon the life of another.

Law Enforcement: Presented to a law enforcement officer whose life-saving actions exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.

Medical: Presented to a medical professional, organization, or individual whose life-saving action or preparedness exemplifies the very highest standards of their calling.

Lifeline: Presented to an individual, a 9-1-1 dispatcher or caller, paramedic, or EMT who utilized emergency communications, or preparedness, such as training or tools, to save the life of another.

Military: Presented to a member of the Armed Forces (active or former, commissioned or non-commissioned) whose life-saving actions or preparedness exemplify the very highest standards of their calling, or to a person/organization dedicated to veteran services.

Workplace Safety: Presented to a business owner, manager, or employee whose preparedness or life-saving actions exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.
