Southern Tier Real Heroes Award Categories and Definitions

Animal Rescue: Presented to the owner(s) of a pet who was instrumental in saving a life, or individual(s) who was instrumental in saving an animal's life.

Blood Donor/Services: Presented to an individual or organization that has helped save lives through blood donations or created awareness of the importance of blood donations.

Education: Presented to an individual(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another in an educational setting, an educator(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another in the community, or an educator(s) who teaches the importance of preparedness or life-saving skills.

Fire Rescue: Presented to an individual(s) whose life-saving actions or preparedness saved the life of another from a fire.

Good Neighbor: Presented to an individual(s) or organization that has saved the lives of community members or had an otherwise positive impact on the community through a particular program, initiative or good deed.

Adult Good Samaritan (21+): Presented to an individual(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another or had a significant positive impact on the life of another.

Youth Good Samaritan (20 & under): Presented to an individual(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another or had a significant positive impact on the life of another.

Law Enforcement: Presented to a law enforcement officer(s) whose life-saving actions or emergency preparedness exemplify the very highest standards of their calling.

Medical: Presented to an individual(s) whose lifesaving actions or emergency preparedness saved the life of another in a medical emergency.

Lifeline: Presented to an individual(s) who used emergency communications, or emergency preparedness training or tools, to save the life of another in an emergency.

Military: Presented to a member(s) of the Armed Forces (active or former) whose life-saving actions or emergency preparedness exemplify the very highest standards of their calling, or to a person/organization dedicated to veteran services in our community.

Workplace Safety: Presented to a business owner(s), manager(s), or employee(s) who used life-saving skills to save the life of another in a workplace setting, or whose workplace training programs and/or equipment exemplifies the highest standards of proactive emergency preparedness.
