



VIRTUAL ZOMBIE APOCALYPSE PARTY

About

The Zombie Apocalypse Party utilizes an impending 'zombie apocalypse' to help educate your school and community about how to prepare for disasters. This is a virtually adapted event (see original guide [here](#)) where youth can still dress in their best zombie costumes and enjoy virtual games and other fun activities while educating themselves and their community about ways to survive a zombie outbreak.

Detailed Timeline

Step 1: Logistics Planning [1 Month Prior]

- Reach out to your local Red Cross contact who can guide you to resources to help make your event more impactful and successful.

- Decide on a video calling platform (e.g. Microsoft Teams, Zoom, or Google Meet) for your event. Feel free to use a platform with Breakout Rooms to split into smaller groups!

Step 2: Event Development [3 Weeks Prior]

- Develop activity ideas—here are some to get you started:
 - Create a game about making an emergency plan (see emergency plan template [here](#))
 - Give participants different zombie scenarios to respond to in a limited amount of time
 - Host a Virtual Preparedness Scavenger Hunt (see guide [here](#))
 - Download the Red Cross Emergency mobile app [here](#) and make an emergency plan
 - Have a contest for the best zombie costume after having each youth share their costume
 - Create a trivia game of survival tips—create questions about all disasters (see facts [here](#))
 - Have attendees create a Red Cross Emergency Contact Card (see fillable card [here](#))
 - Host a digital poster contest (using a shared slide, document, or whiteboard) where students can design and create posters illustrating ways to be prepared

- Create an agenda for the activity that includes an outline of icebreakers, games, and time breakdowns.

Step 3: Promotion & Organization [2 Weeks Prior]

- Team up with other Red Cross Clubs or organizations in your community to increase involvement.

- Post event details on your local Red Cross region calendar and social media.

- Collect participant registrations and share any important information or materials prior -- including instructions about fun costumes to participate in the event.

Step 4: Hosting the Event [Day of]

- Follow your event agenda and encourage conversation among youth volunteers.

- Have fun!
